The library has 4 Verizon Hotspots for patron to checkout. A hotspot is a small device you can use to connect a wireless device, such as a laptop, smartphone or tablet to the internet. Hotspots are portable, so you can connect your device to the internet almost anywhere you are through the Verizon network.

To be eligible to check out a hotspot from the library, a user must:

• Be a library card holder in good standing with no outstanding charges, or missing items, and have a current account.

• Be at least 18 years of age with a valid driver's license or state ID with current name and address.

• Read, understand, and sign the Hotspot Lending/Borrower Agreement.

If you feel that you meet the eligibility requirements for checking out a device, please come to the library to check one out. Items will be checked out on a first come, first serve basis for a period of 3 weeks, with up to one renewal if there is not a waiting list. Otherwise, patrons will be added to the waiting list.
